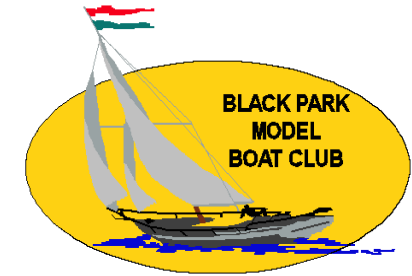

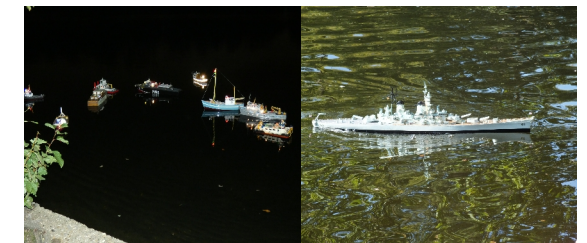

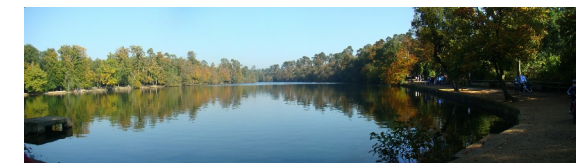

The club has the use of the lake at Black Park on Thursday afternoons from 12pm and Sunday mornings. The address is Black Park Road, Slough, SL3 6DS and is signposted from the A412 between Slough and Iver Heath. There is a large pay and display car park near the lake. The 500 acre park has toilets and cafés. The lake is open for sailing whenever the Park is open.

The club also meets every other month in the Harvey Memorial Hall, George Green Rd, George Green, Slough SL3 6BJ where we start with a short business meeting, followed by talks, bring and buy sales, a Fish Supper, demonstrations and the occasional film show.. The meetings start at 8pm.



Once a year there is a whole day regatta at the lake where other clubs are invited and money raised for a local charity. In the past we have supported the RNLI, The Bucks Air Ambulance and the Thames Hospice.

The club regularly displays at national and local model shows such as Beale Park, Alfold, Sumners Pond and the Warwick International Boat show.
